1. **Program Overview** - Subject to these Terms and Conditions, this program is offered by KeySpan Gas d/b/a National Grid ("the Company" or "National Grid"), through its contractual vendor Association of Energy Affordability (the "Vendor") to Company customers in Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island and Long Island New York who meet Company income eligibility guidelines.
2. **Customer Eligibility** - At least 50% of the households must meet income eligibility requirements to qualify. Programs are available to National Grid residential gas heating customers and gas water heating customers on a firm account, rather than interruptible. The owner must complete an application and provide proof of property ownership. An investment by the owner is required unless the owner is income eligible and lives in the property.
